DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES:

2. Surgical Procedures: Minor surgical procedures Level 1 under Enhanced Service joint injections.

3. Diagnostic and Screening procedures: General practice services for our registered patients and, on occasions patients registered with other GP practices or temporary residents. Specific diagnostic procedures eg phlebotomy and sexual health. Specific screening programmes such as cervical screening are also undertaken.

4. Maternity Services. General practice services offered and provided in conjunction with community midwives for the assessment, treatment and education of patients in the antenatal period as well as post-delivery.

5. Family Planning and Sexual Health and Reproductive services
